undertakes commitments for acceding the WTO**

*Upon its accession to the WTO, Russia will open to some extent respective
sectors to foreign persons*

WTO

*Upon accession to the WTO Russia may set any restrictions relating to
supply of services by foreign persons in the following sectors*

1. Pipeline transport (transportation of fuels, transportation of other goods);
2. Rental of vessels with crew, maintenance and repair of vessels, manoeuvring services, supporting services for maritime transport (port, piloting, navigation services, services for salvaging and/or raising of vessels, servicing of vessels, etc.);
3. Internal waterways transport services (passenger transportation, freight transportation, rental of vessels with crew, inland and other vessels, manoeuvring services);
4. Air transport services (passenger transportation, freight transportation, rental of aircrafts with crew, airports services, management of air traffic, servicing of passengers and/or aircrafts);
5. Space transportation;
6. Rail transport services (passenger transportation, freight transportation, manoeuvring services, supporting services for rail transport);
7. Road transport services in terms of rental of commercial vehicles with operatorⁱ;
8. Radio and television transmission services;
9. Sound recording services;
10. Social services (care of the elderly, children, the handicapped with or without accommodation, vocational rehabilitation, etc.);
11. Research and development services on natural sciences, interdisciplinary spheres;
12. Veterinary services;
13. Sporting and other entertainment services (organization of sports events both for professionals and non-professionals);
14. Libraries, archives, museums and other cultural services;
15. Sports sections and clubs, parks and beaches services;
16. Postal services;
17. Gambling services.

- services for exploitation of highways, bridges and tunnels;
